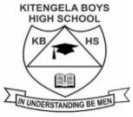

SUMMARY OF GUIDELINES IN EXPECTED BEHAVIOUR
(A MUST FOR ALL STUDENTS AND PARENTS)

Generally, the school community expects that all persons associated with the school will do their uttermost to make life manageable in the school. It is expected that every student will use common sense at all times, behave well and treat each other well in order to grow friendly members of the Kitengela Boys family.

1. A student in Kitengela Boys will respect God, respect all other members of the community and respect himself. As a school established on Christian faith and belief, all students will attend school assemblies, parade and prayer meetings.
2. As an education institution, every student who joins Kitengela Boys will work to the uttermost to achieve top grades in the subjects that he takes. As much as possible, the KCPE mark should be maintained or improved during the course of the secondary education. A student who deliberately declines in performance may be required to seek admission in alternative institution.
3. Students will maintain cleanliness at all times. Personal hygiene must be maintained by every student. Every student has a responsibility to work and maintain the prescribed areas. Environmental conservation is required by all.
4. All students remain in the school throughout except when permitted to go out during official functions. A student who must go home during the term will be issued with a leave pass, which must be countersigned by the parent and surrendered to the Deputy Principal on return. Sneaking out of school shall lead to suspension with a penalty of buying two chain links or an equivalent of Ksh 10,000.
5. Every student will maintain, conserve and account for furniture and all the equipment given to them by the school.
6. Every student’s fees must be paid at the prescribed time. Failure to pay fees will result in the student being sent home.
7. Students will wear the prescribed school uniforms in the right shade at all time during the term. Home clothes are not allowed in school. The fleece jacket should not have hood.
8. Mobile phones, sim cards, flash discs, laptop, radios or electronic gadgets are NOT allowed in the school. Such unauthorised items will be confiscated and not returned to the defaulter and may lead to automatic expulsion from school.
9. Smoking, tattooing, Metal plates on the teeth, ear piercing, drinking alcohol or being involved in drug abuse will lead to immediate and automatic expulsion from school. Being involved in acts of lawfulness or rudeness to authority will lead to immediate and /or automatic expulsion. Satanism, homosexual, rape, being in possession of pornographic materials and any other infamous conduct may also lead to automatic exclusion.
10. Bullying or “monolising will draw severe punishment for the bullies leading to EXCLUSION from the school. Fighting may also lead to exclusion from school. In both cases the student will be suspended from school and will be required to undergo professional counselling.
11. Every student must be loyal to the school and must be ready and willing to contribute positively (by making suggestions through the class representatives, the class teachers, and the Deputy Principal or suggestion box.) without fear. This way we shall create a wonderful home – The Kitengela Boys.
12. Each student “shall” be a member of at least one club and participate in one sport game. Students who excel in academics will be allowed to lead other as members of the Student Council. Improper leadership will result in suspension and demotion.
13. Theft of any item will lead to suspension and replacement of three times the value of the stolen item. Students wearing others uniform will be deemed as theft.
14. Arsonists will be handed over to the police for criminal prosecution. They will be required to meet the value of the destroyed items and other costs if any.
15. Suspension will lead to punishment, undergoing counselling or appearing before the Disciplinary Committee.
